

Importance of the Jarrah Forest

Topic: Rehabilitation

You Will Need:

- Two sheets of A3 paper
- Pencils.

What You Need To Do:

- Form groups and brainstorm ideas on A3 sheet, for why the Jarrah Forest is important
- Decide on four headings to categorise the ideas (e.g. environmental, economic, cultural, and recreational) – Fold the second A3 sheet into four then cut out the ideas and place them under the relevant headings
- Share ideas with the whole class
- Compare category choices
- Which category had the greatest number of ideas?
- Rank the ideas in order of importance and compare the results
- What can be deduced from the results?

Extension/Alternatives

- Form debating teams to debate which is most important
- Create a poster
- Create a brochure.
