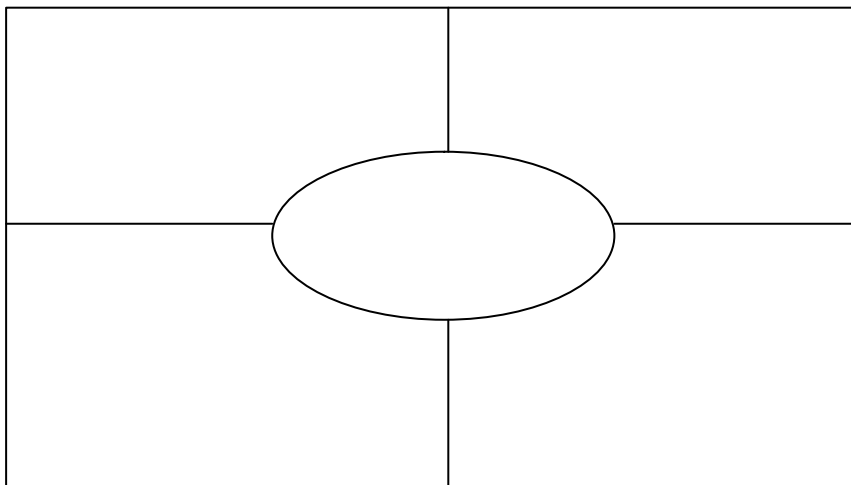
Topic: Recycling

What You Need To Do:

Each person gets to speak, UNINTERRUPTED, for one minute. Nobody can argue with you during your minute, they simply wait their turn to share their thoughts on the topic.
