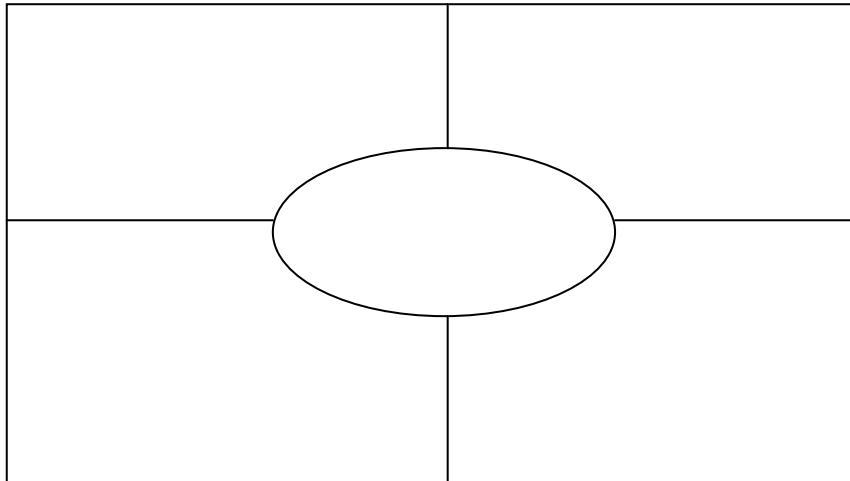


## Have Your Say
