




Engineered Products & Solutions (EPS) 2007 Community Leadership Awards

	<p style="text-align: center;">1st PLACE: Auburn, Indiana Alcoa Auto and Truck Structures</p>	<p>The Auburn, Indiana facility was cited for outstanding partnership with the community, providing more than \$120,000 in grants and 800 volunteer hours by approximately 40% of its employee population in 2006. As first-place winner, Auburn was awarded an additional \$25,000 in Alcoa Foundation grants to use in their community.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">2nd PLACE: Eastman, Georgia Alcoa Architectural Products (APP) Building and Construction Systems</p>	<p>The Eastman, Georgia facility donated over \$80,000 and 47 employees volunteered more than 420 hours to community organizations in 2006. For its efforts, Eastman will receive an additional \$15,000 in Alcoa Foundation grants to use in their community.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">3rd PLACE: Morristown, Tennessee Alcoa Power & Propulsion</p>	<p>The Morristown, Tennessee facility took third place for its strong community relations program, winning an additional \$10,000 in Alcoa Foundation grants to use in their community. The facility received the Morristown Area Chamber of Commerce Industrial Appreciation Award for capital investment and job creation for 2006.</p>
