We've always talked about Narrows Unit 4 as having 2 aeration valves. However, when I went back to look at the recent Voith report, they discuss two aeration "systems"; a vacuum breaker system and the peripheral aeration system. During my first review of the Voith report I just assumed the peripheral aeration was the 2 aeration valves. But now I'm not sure. Do the two systems (peripheral and VB) represent the 2 "aeration valves" that we've always talked about? Or are the two tap locations on the peripheral aeration shown in Figure 2 of the Voith report the 2 aeration valves. It's been so long since I was shown the Unit 4 aeration, I can't really remember what it looked like. Has something changed? Can we discuss when you get a minute? -W
