<p><b>Overview</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Huntly mine is the world’s second largest bauxite mine, supplying ore to Pinjarra and Kwinana alumina refineries. It was established in 1976 and is located near Dwellingup in Western Australia.</li> <li>• In 2015 Huntly mine supplied approximately 24.5 million tonnes of bauxite via a direct overland conveying system to Pinjarra alumina refinery, and via an overland conveyor and rail to Kwinana alumina refinery. The current crusher is located at Myara.</li> <li>• Huntly mines bauxite from within a defined Mineral Lease (known as ML1SA).</li> <li>• Alcoa’s mining operations are overseen by the Mining and Management Program Liaison Group (MMPLG), which consists of representatives from across government. The MMPLG is responsible for reviewing mine plans and associated activities and making recommendations to the Western Australian Minister for State Development.</li> <li>• Bauxite ore from Huntly and Willowdale mines helps to produce approximately 43 per cent of Australia’s alumina and 20 per cent of Australia’s aluminium.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Economic Impact</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Approximately 590 employees and 110 contractors work at Huntly mine.</li> <li>• In 2015, the mine injected approximately AU\$75 million into the local community through salaries, wages and benefits, and approximately AU\$16 million in local supply contracts.</li> <li>• In 2015, Alcoa of Australia injected approximately AU\$395 million into Australia’s local, state and federal governments through the payment of royalties, taxes, rates and charges. Approximately AU\$99.2 million was paid to Western Australian local and state governments.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Community</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In 2015, the mine invested approximately AU\$66,000 into community organisations and initiatives focused on education, environmental initiatives and workforce development.
