

Operations

- Huntly Bauxite Mine was established in 1976 and is located east of North Dandalup in Western Australia (WA). It currently supplies ore to Pinjarra Alumina Refinery.
- The mine is located within a defined Mineral Lease, known as ML1SA. To date, we have cleared less than four per cent of our mineral lease.
- As bauxite forms in shallow pods, a constantly moving mining footprint occurs followed by
 progressive, leading rehabilitation. Mining is currently located at Myara. The proposed next mining
 areas are Myara North and Holyoake, for more information visit our website.
- We do not mine in old growth forest, gazetted national parks or areas of high conservation value.
- Alcoa's mining operations are overseen by multiple government agencies that review mine plans and associated activities and make recommendations to the Western Australian Minister for State and Industry Development.
- In 2023, Huntly supplied approximately 23.8 million tonnes of bauxite to Pinjarra and Kwinana (now curtailed) refineries.

Economic Impact

- Approximately 740 direct employees and 350 contractors work at Huntly mine.
- In 2023, 88 per cent of Alcoa Australia's annual revenue stayed in Australia through wages, local spend, taxes, royalties and dividends to Australian shareholders.
- Our WA operations injected approximately AU\$755 million into the local WA community through direct salaries, wages and benefits and AU\$1.9 billion was invested with some 920 WA suppliers.
 - Huntly mine's contribution was approximately AU\$120 million into the local WA community through salaries, wages and benefits and approximately AU\$227 million in WA supply contracts.
- Our Australian operations combined injected AU\$397 million into Australia's local, state and federal governments through the payment of royalties, taxes, rates and charges.
- Alcoa of Australia produces a Tax Transparency Report in support of high standards of corporate governance and an open approach to business conduct.

Employer of Choice

- Our values are act with integrity, operate with excellence, care for people and lead with courage.
- We seek to provide a trusting workplace that is safe, respectful and inclusive of all individuals and reflects the diversity of the communities in which we operate.
- We have four employee action groups AWN: Alcoa Women's Network; AWARE: Alcoans Working Actively for Racial-Ethnic Equality; EAGLE: Employees at Alcoa for Gay, Lesbian, bisexual and transgender Equality; ABLE: Alcoans moving Beyond Limited Expectations.
- Alcoa has been named an employer of choice by the Federal Government's Workplace Gender Equality Agency for the 23rd year. Flexible work practices at Alcoa mean employees can balance their personal interests and family life alongside their work commitments.

Community Engagement

- Huntly mine engages with the community through a variety of community activities and forums.
- In 2023, Alcoa Foundation and Alcoa Australia invested AU\$5.2 million into areas of need and worthy
 causes in WA communities near where we operate.
 - Huntly mine invested approximately AU\$260,000 into local community and charitable initiatives, along with further in-kind contributions.
- Alcoa employees nationwide initiated 56 Alcoans Coming Together In Our Neighbourhoods (ACTION) events which saw local community organisations benefit from employee volunteer support and a \$3000 grant.



Environment and Sustainability

- Alcoa is a recognised world leader in mine site rehabilitation (see <u>factsheet</u> and <u>video</u>) and was the
 first mining company in the world to achieve 100 per cent plant species richness in our WA
 rehabilitated mining areas.
- In 2024, we established a dedicated <u>Forest Research Centre</u> and announced \$15 million of research funding over five years to support research programs.
- In 2023, 454 hectares of mined land was rehabilitated at our Huntly and Willowdale bauxite mines. Of the area we have mined, more than 75 per cent has been rehabilitated and is at different stages of development.
- Environmental stewardship is Alcoa's priority, and we implement industry-leading processes to mitigate biodiversity impacts from our operations.
- All Australian mining, refining and smelting operations have earned certification from the <u>Aluminium Stewardship Initiative</u>, which is validation of our commitment to responsible and sustainable production and working with stakeholders to deliver long-term value.

Alcoa in Australia

- Alcoa has operated in Australia for 61 years and over this time has invested approximately AU\$14.9 billion in establishing the Australian business.
- Alcoa's Australian operations represent one of the world's largest integrated bauxite mining, alumina refining and aluminium smelting systems.
- In 2023, our two bauxite mines and three alumina refineries in WA produced about 50 per cent of Australia's alumina. In Victoria, Portland Aluminium Smelter (which is 55 per cent owned by Alcoa of Australia) produced 18 per cent of the nation's aluminium.
- In 2023, Alcoa directly employed 4950 people, predominantly from regional WA and Victoria. AU\$831 million was paid in wages and benefits to our employees.
- Wherever we operate in Australia, we acknowledged the Traditional Owners of the lands and pay respects to their elders past, present and emerging. Learn about our reconciliation commitments.
