Operations

- The Wenatchee plant began operations in 1952.
- The site occupies approximately 2,800 acres, including 70 acres of orchards.
- The fully curtailed site has an annual capacity of 184,000 metric tons of aluminum per year, and includes a carbon plant, three smelter lines and a casthouse.
- All remaining capacity at Wenatchee was completed by the end of 2015. The casthouse has been fully curtailed since the end of December 2015.

Economic Impact

- Pre-curtailment economic impact of \$53 million in payroll.

Community Engagement

- \$12,000 in annual charitable contributions.

- Environmental Management System (EMS) ensuring strict environmental protection standards.
